3. 9/11 events and Traffic Advisory:

a. Memory Walk/5K run sponsored by Alzheimer's Association, Aloha Chapter. The event is expected to have 1,000 participants. It will start at 7 am from Fisherman's Wharf near Ward Avenue, and continue along Ala Moana Blvd to the kokohead entrance to Ala Moana Park, circle Magic Island, exit the park and end at the start area. The event will end at about 9am.

b. Taste of Kalihi, starts 10 am , ends 9pm. Sponsored by the Filipino Chamber of Commerce Foundation/City & County of Honolulu. Event is expected to have 3,000+ participants. Colburn Street from McNeil Street and halfway to Waiakamilo Road will be closed.

c. September 11 is recognized by the City and County of Honolulu by a **Walk of Remembrance** that starts near the Police Department headquarters on South Beretania Street, then to the Honolulu Fire Department headquarters near South and Queen Streets, ending at City Hall near the 9/11 memorial. The walk starts at 5:30 pm and ends at 8:00pm.
