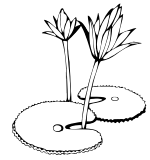




**MOILILI HONGWANJI MISSION**  
**CENTENNIAL SERVICE AND BANQUET**  
**SUNDAY, MARCH 26, 2006**  
**“Seeds for the Future”**



Please join us on **Sunday, March 26, 2006** as we commemorate Moiliili Hongwanji Mission's rich 100-year history and remember with gratitude the many people whose great effort and dedication have made this celebration possible. As we go into our second century of Nembutsu sharing, let us take this opportunity to embrace our Centennial Theme of planting and nurturing “Seeds for the Future”.

The Commemoration Service begins at **9:00 AM** and will be a very beautiful and special one befitting this once-in-a-lifetime occasion. Our wonderful traditional rituals will be enhanced by a Hawaiian chant, our new Hawaiian quilt altar cloths, our originally composed Centennial Song, and the recognition of the winners of the Moiliili Hongwanji Buddhist Women's Association's Youth Art and Essay Contests.

Following the service, the commemorative photo will be taken, and we will then proceed to the Japanese Cultural Center of Hawaii for the banquet which begins at **11:30 AM**. There, we'll enjoy a taiko performance by Kenny Endo's group, a delicious buffet lunch, and a wonderful program of entertainment by members, Preschool children, Dharma School students, Happy Strummers, and our recently-formed Choir. A powerpoint presentation of photos highlighting Moiliili's Hongwanji's history will also be shown. The schedule for the day is:

- 8:15 AM: Doors open
- 9:00 AM: Commemoration Service at the Temple
- 10:30 AM: Commemorative Photo
- 11:30 AM - 2:00 PM: Centennial Banquet at JCCH

The cost for the luncheon is \$15 for adults and \$5 for children from 6 to 12 years old. There is no charge for children 5 and under. (The temple will subsidize the balance.) We ask that you send in the form below with your payment by Sunday, March 5. Parking will be available at the JCCH from early in the morning and the fee is \$3.00 with validation. There will be a shuttle between the JCCH and the temple from 8:00 to 9:00 AM, from 11:00 to 11:30 AM and from 2:00 to 2:30 PM. Transportation may also be arranged from home for those who request it.
